Lost Legacy School of Mixed Martial Arts of South Florida, USA is the one of the most sought after systems, highly recognized for its realistic combat, high energy and explosive styles effective in any and all fight circumstances.

Master Le Grand is an 8th Dan/Degree Black Belt and Master under Tiger Jude's 7 Styles Kung Fu with over 38+ years of experience in Martial Arts and 20+ years as a Master Instructor. He credits his boundless achievements to the esteemed lineage and pedigree from which he descends. Master Le Grand trained in the Arts under the tutelage of his uncles, 9th Dan Grand Master "Tiger" Paul Innocent and 10th Dan Grand Master Monk Dr. Jude Innocent, descendent of Grand Master Sifu Carter Wong.

Grand Master Monk Dr. Jude Innocent is a pioneer of the Martial Arts and the founder of Tiger Jude's Seven Styles System and Organization, under the tutelage of the great Grand Master Sifu Carter Wong. Grand Master Carter Wong is best known for his immense contributions to the martial arts film genre, starring in and contributing to over 100 films including Big Trouble in Little China. He is the founder of the International Chung Hop Kuen Federation and influenced Master Le Grand's uncle, Grand Master Monk. Dr. Jude Innocent to form The New Shaolin Boxing Association. Both are still active, honored ambassadors to the Arts today and influence the creed that Master Le Grand lives by as well as the philosophy that he bestows upon his students each day: "The Legacy Continues."
